Jennifer Cochrane has been creating *Impossible Shadows* since 2016. These works remove shadows from existing sculptures she has created and reinterpret them in new surroundings. The shadows have progressed through dimensions over this time beginning with 2-dimensional, site-specific, tape installations that then became reinterpreted into large sculptures which then cast their own shadow and so it goes on. This exhibition continues this exploration and considers how shadows reveal information that define a moment in time and place. Point of view determines the interpretation of the works.
